



**Prosecution of Salvatore Chiodo (known as Sam Chiodo)**

Melbourne Magistrates' Court - 8 November 2016

The accused, Sam Chiodo, pleaded guilty to two charges contrary to the *Architects Act 1991* relating to holding himself out as an architect and holding out his business, Area Design, to be an architectural firm. The accused had committed the offences by advertising on the internet and in promotional material for various developments.

The accused was sentenced, with conviction, and order to pay a fine in the sum of \$10,000. The accused was also ordered to pay the ARBV's legal costs in the amount of \$8,800.
