	<p>architect ineligible to nominate as a candidate for the election?</p>	<p>The Information Sheet Victorian Government – Board Appointments provides further advice on conflicts of interest.</p> <p>ARBV also applies the following protocols recognising that conflicts may arise from a particular circumstance encountered post appointment:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Directors are required to inform the Chairperson and Board Secretary as soon as practicable of any conflicts of interest (actual, potential or perceived) they may have in relation to their role as an ARBV Director or on particular items of business.</li> <li>• At the commencement of each Board meeting the Chairperson will ask if Director’s present has an interest in relation to any matter on the agenda. Directors must declare any interests even it has been declared previously or is identified on the register of personal interests. Where a conflict exists, the Director will not participate or be present for the item.</li> </ul>
